4th Annual Nordic Roundup

- This annual event was created in 2018 by the **Swedish Packraft Association**. The goal of the Nordic Roundup is to federate a community in Scandinavia around common values.
- Every year we organize an event in a different Nordic country: Sweden in 2019, Norway in 2022 (post Covid) and then Finland in 2023. For the 2024 event we are returning to Sweden.
- We want to organize a slightly different event and want to involve active actors in our growing sport while helping to protect the natural environments in which we operate.
- The event The 4th annual Nordic Roundup will take place from 25 to 28 June 2024 in Dala-Floda, a white water hotspot in Sweden where the Västa Dalälven river flows.
- Navigation possibilities are multiple and adapted to all skill levels (class 2 to 4).
- The event will be hosted and organized in collaboration with Kajaktiv, which is a major partner of the roundup this year.


Schedule:

Thursday and Friday (June 25-26): various paid packraft technical courses (introduction, intermediate and river safety) supervised by Jeremie Lamart (IRF, NPF) and Fredrik Feyling (IRF, NPF).

Saturday (June 27): different free clinics, varied themes, supervised by volunteers. Packraft race on Lissfors, community meal, raffle, movie night.

Sunday (June 28): participants organize their own outings.

The roundup is a social event that aims to connect the local and international packraft community while developing the notion of river safety in order to create a high standard of safety within the packrafting community.



Education

The majority of the work during the roundup is carried out by the organizers and volunteers who offer their time and make their knowledge and expertise available to the participants. The instructors who will offer clinics are recognized and important players in the world of packraft and who devote a significant part of their time to the development of the sport as well as the development of innovative technical and safety education.

Conservation

The preservation of natural environments is one of the values we want to highlight this year. We wish to participate in the conservation effort by helping associations engaged in the fight against dams and the preservation of the ecological environments of the river.

The beneficiary association this year will be Älvräddarna.

Älvräddarna is fighting for existing hydropower to be adapted to the environment with fishways, fin nets, diversions, eel guides, minimum bottling, etc.

Stop all new expansion of hydropower, extraction of unnecessary hydropower. For example. the one that produces very little electricity but destroys important waterways, flowing watercourses can (if restored and freed from hydropower) become an important foundation for the livelihood of sparsely populated areas. This, in the form of sustainable sport fishing tourism, ecotourism, white water rafting, rafting, etc.







Sponsors

We offer companies related to our sport the opportunity to participate in our event by becoming a sponsor. Companies wishing to sponsor the event can do so in the form of donations items (gear, vouchers, etc.) that will be the prizes for the raffle to the benefit of the Älvräddarna association.

Levels of sponsorship:

- Class 1: value of the donation between 300sek and 1000sek (30 and 100 euros)
- Class 2: value of the donation between 1000sek and 4000sek (100 and 400 euros)
- Class 3: value of the donation between 4000sek and 10.000sek (400 and 1000 euros)
- Class 4: value of the donation above 10.000sek (above 1000 euros)

The sponsorship benefits are as follows:

- Large logo on event page (level 4) or small logo on event page (level1-3)
- Company logo included on event banners (level 2-4)
- Possibility of having a booth to display your products during the roundup (from Level 3)

Registration

Fee registration for the roundup is 600sek for 2 days (Saturday and Sunday), it includes:

- Event administration
- Accommodation for 2 nights bed in shared room or camping (Friday-Saturday)
- Access to bathroom and showers.
- Community meal with one drink (sponsored by Kajaktiv)
- Access to clinics during the weekend.
- Registration for the packraft race.

200sek per extra night (Wednesday, Thursday or Sunday). Option to rent a sauna for groups of 4-8 people for 90 minutes at a time.
